- Swimmers may enter a total of four (4) events per day, with a maximum of two (2) individual events and three (3) relays
- Each school is allowed four (4) individuals in each event
- Each school is allowed one (1) team in each relay event
- If an individual swims in the Developmental Competition on Friday, he/she may only enter relays on Saturday
- Consolation Finals will precede Championship Finals in the evening session
- Alternates wishing to compete in the Consolation Final must be in starter's area and ready to swim when called

DIVING COMPETITION

Number of Dives: Divers will perform a total of eleven (11) dives; five (5) voluntary dives shall come from each of the five (5) groups, and

shall have a true "dd", and six (6) optional dives shall include at least one (1) chosen from each of the five (5) groups.

No more than one (1) optional dive from the same group is permitted through semifinals.

Entry Procedure: Please follow information posted to the FSPA Invitational Website to assure proper entry procedure for all diving.

Minimum DD: Minimum dive degree of difficulty is 12.2 (for optional dives only)

Dive Order: Number of Divers Preliminaries

1 – 32 Any 2 required + 3 optional in any order

Semi Finals Finals

2 required + 1 optional in any order 1 required + 2 optional in any order

If there are 33 or more contestants, the field will be cut to the top 32 divers with the highest cumulative score after three (3) rounds of dives. The number of qualifiers for the semi-finals (rounds 6 - 8) shall be four (4) more than the number of places to be scored (20 semi-finalists). The number of qualifiers for the finals (rounds 9 - 11) shall be equal to the number of places to be scored (16 finalists).
